Highfield Level 2 International Award in The Control of Substances Hazardous to Health (COSHH)

The Level 2 International Award in Control of Substances Hazardous to Health is a qualification suitable for anyone working in areas such as manufacturing, cleaning, healthcare, transport and office environments, who may come into contact with hazardous substances.

This qualification is designed to give learners the knowledge, skills and understanding to recognise the risks and control measures when dealing with substances hazardous to health. Topics covered include how risk assessments support the safe use of hazardous substances and the effects of exposure to hazardous substances.

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

This qualification is usually achieved by taking a one-day (5 hours) classroom-based course.

How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed by the following method:
