

## Level 2 Award in Understanding Stewarding at Spectator Events (11 credits, 36 GLH)

### 1. About the qualification

The purpose of the Level 2 Award in Understanding Stewarding at Spectator Events qualification is to provide learners, with the knowledge and understanding required to enter the Spectator Safety sector.

It is specifically suited to volunteers at spectator events supporting more experienced staff. Upon completion of the award the learner meets the requirements at section 4.10 b of the Guide to Safety at Sports Grounds, "Green Guide". The learner should undertake further training and assessment of competence to obtain the Level 2 Certificate in Spectator Safety if wishing to continue in employment in the sector.
